2024 Programme

The INTBAU Summer School Incubator will run from 13 – 18 August in the Netherlands and Belgium. A series of focused workshops will provide a window onto the practical questions that will underpin your own future plans to run a summer school.

The programme will conclude in Bruges on 17 August with a combined celebration and exhibition that concludes INTBAU Belgium's summer school programme as the INTBAU Summer School Gathering.

Provisional schedule

This schedule is still subject to revision as we collaborate with our chapters.

13 August	Arrive in the Netherlands and make your way to Utrecht for the start of the incubator.
14 August	On site on the INTBAU Netherlands incubator: Let's build a beautiful city.
	Meet programme leads Joseph and Ruben, as well as students.
	Discuss: Structuring a successful programme, teaching methodologies, finding your niche in the market, growing from start-up and delivering on a shoestring
15 August	Final student presentations of INTBAU NL Summer School. See the result of the students' work and how this prepares them for a career in traditional architecture.
	Travel to Bruges in the evening. (3.5 hour transfer by road)
16 August	Meet convenors of summer schools beyond Netherlands and Belgium. We hope here to meet representatives of summer schools including Mexico, Spain/Portugal, Norway and possibly Australia.
	Roundtable discussion on the process of establishing a summer school and the support available within the INTBAU group.
	In the afternoon, meet also with Nadia and Noé from INTBAU Belgium for a discussion on how to maximise your impact, support students into further work, involve craft within a programme. Included in this conversation will be graduates from various summer schools around the network.



17 August	INTBAU Summer School Gathering

	Celebration in Bruges' Begijnhof (Beguinage) as we tour the exhibition of summer school results.
18 August	Breakfast with entire group and then close.
